<u>Call to Order:</u> The Board was called to order at 5:03 pm by Mike Harper, co-chair.

Approval of Minutes:

Executive Director's Report:

Updates:

- Eileen requested 2.4 million in federal funds. These funds will help cover costs for key personnel needs. Currently hiring for Program Manager of Academic Student Affairs, Undergraduate Pathway Recruiter, and IT Help Desk.

USM Strategic Plan: Eileen shared key questions and takeaways from the Board of Regents retreat.

USM Data:

Eileen distributed program data from USM. This data is associated with RHEC. Eileen discussed how we can use this data for consistent messaging.

Retreat Report Findings:

Lisa Akchin is conducting upcoming focus groups to test current and potential messaging.

High School Influentials:

- Generate ideas from high-school professionals and family influencers about messages and communications channels that will be effective with prospective college students.
- Lisa is working with Superintendents to gather at least 10 participants from each district and 2 volunteers from BOA to attend the November 28th focus group.

Employers and Community:

- Inform employers and other community leaders about the growing set of bachelor's completion programs at USMSM and activate them as champions for student recruitment, degree completion, and employment in the region.
- BoA members should provide 5 names and contact information to Jean. Also need 2 volunteers from BOA to attend the November 29th Community Focus Group
